After reading Malcolm Tibbets' book on segmenting, Kent decided to make his turning a little more simple by devising his jigs that allow making a compound miter with only adjusting the degree adjustment of the miter and not having to adjust the compound degree. With this demo he made our segmenting of Staves so much easier. Thanks Kent!
