on how to cut, glue and turn a decorative table support leg.



Terry started with about 6 bdf of lumber ripped with a 22.5 degree edge for gluing. With the help of his able assistant, Reb, they proceeded to coat the edges with a generous amount of glue and then put the eight sided figure together. Several band clamps and some quick bar clamps hold the project together while the glue dries.

Then the fun begins. An octagon cap is mounted to both ends and the resulting tube is mounted on the lathe.
