The last newsletter had a mention of the demo given by Paul Carlson on turning wood with flaws. Here are a few pics of the demo.









#### Nov 6 Demo


Chuck Kuether gave a very timely demo on a segmented ornament just in time for the holidays.

#### Tip of the Month

For those turners that have trouble sliding the banjo on their PM 3520, especially at the extreme ends, remove the banjo from the ways, and lubricate the eccentric tensioner. Use steel wool or Scotchbtite pads and remove all the dust and gunk from the shaft. Wipe clean with mineral spirits or thinner, and spray with Glidecoat, or apply wax, and polish until smooth. Good wood guys has the Glidecoat for sale. Also at that time, use the that stuff on the bed ways. You will be now sliding easily.
