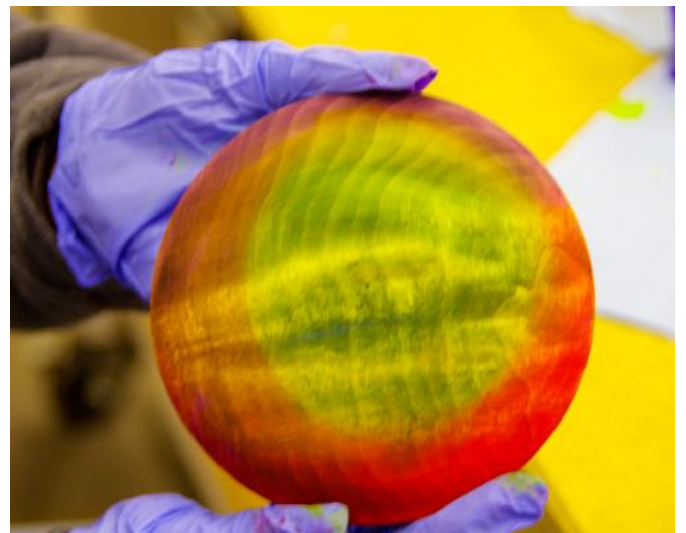
Save the Date

Coloring Wood Demo

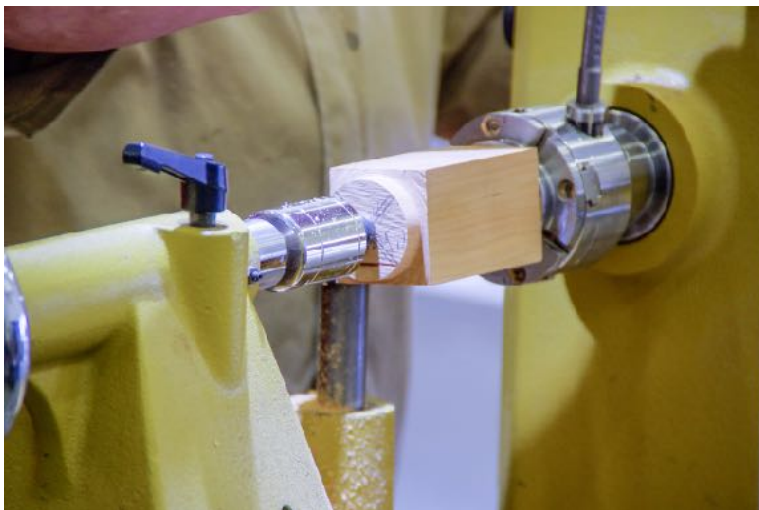
